What do you think about our plans for our other projects and activities?: We need to accept that the best position for the second SH1 bridge is off the end of West Street and through Tinwald (where traffic is already accepted for volume and noise levels), land is already available, children and elderly are not put at extra risk (if you persist with the Chalmers Ave option), our town will not lose through traffic (and be strangled like Temuka), and Land Transport should be funding the whole project, as it is their responsibility. Most of the Ashburton residents agree with the option of utilizing the West street bridge option. Your consultant reports are flawed. You are not listening to your rate paying residents - lets not go down the same track as the Arts Center debarcle (and Angus didn't listen to a huge gathering saying no to the project before it started) Yes, we do live on Chalmers Avenue (and am acutely aware of the amount of heavy traffic and agricultural vehicles which are already using this route) but we have always lived in the Hampstead area and would be against your Chalmers Ave proposal if we lived anywhere else in town as well.
