What do you think about our plans for our other projects and activities?:

1. Curb and channel as required around the township especially for the Village Green on Ashburton Gorge Road with consideration for your buses and cars for the impending build of the Information Station.
2. Street lighting down Ashburton Gorge Road and other roads to be identified and installed.
3. Can Council conduct a Dark Sky Quality Survey at Mount Somers township and Lake Clearwater within a year. Then following this survey; by 2023, have Council adopt a draft Lighting Management Plan, as outlined in the International Dark Sky Reserve Program. Can Council investigate remedial retrofitted shields to street lighting in Mount Somers township on it's current street lights?
4. Signage needs reviewing; as the township is Mount Somers whereas the mountain is Mt Somers. There seems to be some confusion with naming. Also can consideration be given to inclusion of Maori name for Mt Somers of Te Kie Kie being added.
5. Land development section sizes need to be reviewed as people want smaller sized sections.
6. Reserve Board upgrades of a new Amenity Block and Septic Tank - fully support this and ask if it can be brought forward to Year 2 2022/23.
7. Freedom camping areas along the foothills area - are these being monitored for how many campers are using them?
8. Roading: Arundel Rakaia Gorge Road speed limit of 100kms through township needs to be lowered for safety reasons to 70kms.
9. Ashburton Rakaia Gorge Road safer turning options are required for Hoods Road, Pattons Road and Ashburton Gorge Road.
10. Water scheme - fully support the upgrade for Year 2 and any further investigations into secondary water sources for sustainability.
11. Support appointing a Townsperson for mowing lawns etc.
12. Playground equipment for 12mths to 5year olds is required in the township.
13. Village Green Information Station requires support from Council.
